Conculsion of the 2020-21 Season

With the 2020-21 league season declared null and void the Bedfordshire County Football League season 2020-21 will conclude with the staging of four supplementary cup competitions plus the Bedfordshire FA will continue this seasons Intermediate and Junior Cups which have now reached the Semi-Final stage.

Supplementary Cup Rules to note include.

Player Qualification League Rule 18A modified to read.

A player is one who, being in all other respects eligible, is a Registered Playing Member of the club he wishes to represent on 4th March 2021. No additional players may be registered by the club or transferred in from another club after this date.

A player shall not be eligible to play for a team in any match following the group stage unless he has played in the same Supplementary Group Stage for the team he wishes to represent.

Any registered player of a club eligible to play for a BCFL team may play in any match in the Group stage for that club.

Reporting of Results etc

The home club shall report the result of each Competition Match to the Press and Media Results Secretary within one hour of the end of the match. Failure to do so will incur a fine in accordance with the leagues fine Tariff.

For clarification. One hour after the end of the match is three hours from the scheduled kick off time. 2.30pm kick off. 5.30pm deadline. 6.15pm kick off. 9.15pm deadline. 7.30pm kick off. 10.30pm deadline.

Following which the match results notification shall be correctly completed onto Full Time within 3 days of the date of the game. Failure to do so will incur a fine in accordance with the leagues fine tariff.

For Clarification within 3 days is midnight on the following Wednesday for games played the previous Saturday. For games played on a Monday its midnight on the following Thursday. For games played on a Tuesday its midnight on the following Friday. For games played on a Wednesday its midnight on the following Saturday and for games played on a Thursday its midnight on the following Sunday.

Friday 9th April 2021

Following an absense of some 110 days football return to the Bedfordshire County Football League with the playing of the opening game in the leagues Supplementary Cup C when in a Group D fixture under the floodlights at Hitchin Road, hosts Shefford Town & Campton A played out a 1-1 draw with visitors Brickhill Wanderers. It took the home side just twelve minutes to take the lead via Joss Holland and until six minutes from time before the Wanderers drew level with a goal from Ashley Coleman. Wanderers however were to finish the game with just nine players when first Noel Shankland was to see red for his second bookable offence of the evening followed by a straight red card for Kyle Lewis deep into time added on.

Saturday 10th April 2021.

Supplementary Cup A.

Group A action brought about a 3-1 victory for AFC Oakley at AFC Kempston Town & Bedford College. Nathan Aulsberry, Chisom Amadi and Joe Mcdonagh netting the goals against a lone Town reply from Matt Cheveralls. Whilst Stevington were likewise 3-1 home winners over Riseley Sports. John Turner, Luke Knight and Mitch Crook all marking their scoesheet against a lone reply via Lewis Donald.

In Group B action both games were to go the way of the home sides, Marston Shelton Rovers with goals from Adam Tilson, Nick Skolsky and Markel Cousins beating Wilstead 3-1 whose lone goal from Colin Marshall who then missed from the penalty spot. Whilst Queens Park Crescents were 3-2 victors over Bedford Albion. Andre Brown with a brace plus Fraelias Mienanbolo on the Crescents scoresheet against Albion replies via Dan Jefferies and Charlie Norman.

Group C was to bring about another two home wins and the highest goals tally of 13. Biggleswade FC Reserves the 4-2 winners over Elstow Abbey with goals from Ollie Lee, Kian Coles, Joe Worboys and Jack Dreyer against Abbey replies via an own goal and Scott Joseph. Whilst at Second Meadow Biggleswade United U23 saw off Caldecote 4-3. Danny Carter, Charlie Yearwood, Luke Starnes and Hayden Gardener on the United scorsheet against visiting goals from Luke Gurney twice and Carl Heath.

In Group C there was a 2-0 win for Cranfield United with goals from Courtney Broughton and Antonio Ricciardi at Shefford Town & Campton Reserves. Whilst Crawley Green Reserves were held to a 1-1 home draw by Flitwick Town. Brendan Cowell netting for the home team and Rhys Cadger for the Town.

Supplementary Cup B

Group A action saw Arlesey Town U23 run out the biggest winners of the day with a 7-2 home victory over Flitwick Town Reserves. Archie Sayer and Alfie Odell both netting twice alongside single strikes from Matt Springett, Michael Olabajo and Reece Lambert against Town replies from Liam Newton and Dan Abberley. Whilst Eaton Park Rangers were 2-1 winners at Ickwell & Old Warden. Ahead after just 12 minutes with a strike from Sam Pritchard they then lost Harrison Upton in the 66th minute due to his second yellow card of the afternoon before Callum Taylor increased their lead with only eight minutes left to play only to see James Presland net for the home side five minutes later to set up a tense finish which the Rangers safely saw out.

The lone Group B action saw Lea Sports PSG win 3-2 at Pitstone & Ivinghoe United Reserves. Cam Davies with two bullet headers from corners plus a goal from Joe Hennem doing the damage against home replies via Caden Wilkers and Josh Setchell.

In Group C. Sharnbrook ran out 6-1 winners at Kempston Athletic. Tarik Dallas and Tom Oneill both netting braces alongside single goals from James Watkinson and Joel Ives. The lone Athletic reply coming from Harvey Eagle.

Group D also brought about a single game with Totternoe Reserves winning 3-0 at The 61 FC Luton Reserves.

Bedfordshire FA Intermediate Cup Quater Finals

The biggest win of the day belonged to Stopsley United who were 8-0 home winners over AFC Oakley Reserves. James Potter netting a brace and single goals coming the way of Sam Willett, Brandan Carney, Micheal Carter, Conner Waite, Patrick Daly and Ian McGuinness to earn them a last four trip to Henlow who with goals from Cameron Care and Dan Wilson were 2-1 home winners over AFC Dunstable Development.

For Pines (Luton) it was a 6-1 away win at Cranfield United Reserves. Scott Berry leading the way with a hat-trick, Nathan Miller netting twice and Lee Dimmock once against a lone United reply from Joel McCormick to earn them a trip to St Joseph (Saturday) in the Semi-finals after they ran out 3-0 home winners over Ampthill Town Development thanks to a brace from Peter O'Donnell and a goal from Simon Richards.

Supplementary Cup C

Group A action saw FC Polonia (Luton) emerge the 4-3 home winners over CS Rovers with Marchin Bator netting all four goals against Rovers replies from Shane

Robb twice and Jonas Allen. Whilst Sundon Park Rangers with goals from Joshua Randall and Ben Pincher were 2-1 home victors over Crawley Green U23 for whom James Younger netted.

The lone Group C encounter saw Clifton the 3-2 home winners over Real Haynes. Liam Phillips, Josh Adams and George Dee all finding the back of the net against visiting replies via George Hackett and Chris Clarke.

In Group D it was a 2-2 draw between hosts Caldecote Reserves with a brace of goals from Gusseppe Follano and Renhold for whom Roshan Chagger and Ben Brown found the back of the net.

Bedfordshire FA Junior Cup Quater-Finals

Top scorers of the day were Lancot Park with a 6-3 home victory over Marston Shelton Rovers Reserves. Jamie Nolan leading the way with a hat-trick and joined on their scoresheet by goals from Peter Wilson, Micheal Spencer and Ryan Douglas against Rovers replies from Percy Connelly twice and Carl Borrromeo once, they will now be at home in the Semi-Finals to AFC Bedford United who were 2-1 home victors over St Johns (Luton) whose lone goal came from Nic Palmer.

For Harlington Juniors with a hat-trick from Jamie Small it was a 3-1 away win at Sporting Carpathians for whom Petru Ciochina netted, they will now be at home in a last four tie against Flitwick Town A who required a 4-2 penalty shoot-out win at Wootton Blue Cross after 90 minutes play had seen the sides deadlocked at 0-0 with succesful spot kicks from Max Hughes, Kyle Burnham, Jamie Warne and Matt Hill.
