0. NEW CLUBS/TEAMS

- ❖ A sub-committee of the Management Committee had previously met with representatives of **Biggleswade FC Reserves** and had recommended the team be accepted into the League for season 2017-2018. This was endorsed.
- ❖ Prior to the start of the meeting the Management Committee met with the following new Clubs/Teams:

- ❖ All three Clubs were accepted into the League for season 2017-2018 together with **Bedford Albion Reserves**.

1. PREVIOUS MEETING

- ❖ The minutes of the Management Committee meeting held on 2nd March 2017 and 6th April 2017 were signed as a true record, with the following amendments to the April minutes:
 - 9. Fixture Report:
 - **M&DH Clapham Sports** item 04-02. Should not have a league point deduction for a Cup match, thus point deduction on Refs 04-02A should only be 1 point rather than 2 points.
 - 10. Registrations Report.
 - Notice given to **Flitwick Town 'A'**, **Potton Town** & **Stevington** re outstanding result sheets and possible league sanction under league rule 5H.
 - **Harlington:** fine reference 2017.04-24 for playing ineligible player [2nd occurrence] should also note the Club submitted a falsified on-line match notification. Therefore the fine should be levied under rule 11-C and the fine increased from £30 to £75.
 - **Renhold United:** To consider the charge **1st Occurrence**. Club sought advice from league prior to the match and, as a result of qualification changes **not supplied to the league by the Bedfordshire FA**, they received incorrect information. Omitted words now included.
