Registration Forms (covered under league rule 8)

All registrations are now conducted in Whole Game via each individual clubs Team Administrators and likewise all transfers.

With regard to transfers please note the league will not approve any transfers under the waived banner until the leaving club have notified the league they are happy for the transfer to go ahead.

All clubs are advised/requested to check and ensure all registrations made have transferred correctly across from Whole Game into Full Time.

Full Time Available Players List

Clubs are reminded of the note that appears on your match day available players list which reads. " Players above are registered with the competition on the above date of this game. These may include players who are cup tied, or otherwise not eligible to play because they are under suspension- clubs should check with their County FA or on the Whole Game system for details of current suspensions."

It is the clubs 100% total responsibility to ensure they do not play players who are serving a FA suspension and the league's recommendation they visit the Whole Game system prior to each game to check for any suspensions in place at any given date.

Teamsheet Notes -

. Please note the names of your players must show both forenames and family names and the number of the shirt each player is going to wear in the game.

Far too many clubs in the past couple of seasons failed to display the correct number shirt against their players, please ensure this does not happen again in season 2022-23.

This season, all match officials are being instructed to refuse any sheet not completed in this manner.

Please note the exchange of team sheets should take place at least 15 minutes prior to kick off in presence of the Match Day Referee.

Result Sheets

Please note the deadline for your entry onto the Full Time Website is within 3 days of the match.

Thus the deadline is Tuesday Midnight following any given Saturday game.

For Monday games it would be the Thursday Midnight following and for Wednesday games it's the Saturday Midnight following.

Please ensure you spend a minute or so checking your entry as in each of every weekend last season at least one club and often up to six clubs had omitted to submit a referee mark.

Please note all result sheets are to be retained for possible inspection during the course of the season.

Match Day Reporting of Result (covered under league rule 11B)

The deadline for this to happen is within one hour of the match finishing. To clarify the actual time the league regards this to be three hours from the scheduled kick off time.

If 2pm Kick Off then its 5pm. If 2.30 pm Kick off then its 5.30pm. An additional 15 minutes will be allowed when involved in County Cup/ League Cup Ties that go to a penalty shoot-out.

Please remember if you are the away side in any County Cup Tie against opponents from outside our league then your club becomes responsible for reporting the result as above. Otherwise it's just the home side.

The preferred method is by text to 07779680269 – otherwise a phone call to the same number is quite acceptable – **please refrain from leaving messages on the answer phone**, if the line is busy then please wait a few moments and redial or send a text.

Match Day information required for Press Reports etc.

When reporting the above result please provide the name of your goalscorers and any additional information such as sequence of the scoreline, time of goals, red cards, penalty misses/saves or anything unusual of note.

It would also very much assist if when you are the away team that the same information is supplied.

Action Round-Up Saturday 3rd September 2022

Premier Division supported by Sportsform

The top scorers of the day were Caldecote who went away with a 5-3 victory at Cranfield United. Joe Follano netting twice alongside single goals from Evan Beldon, Jake Bruce and Tom Cookman who then spoilt his copy book by getting red carded. The home replies coming from Brandon Macrae, Luke Gray and Jordan Conway. Whilst the defending champions Biggleswade FC Reserves were beaten 0-2 at home by last seasons third place Sharnbrook with goals from Josh Gibbs and James Barron.

For last seasons runners-up Crawley Green Reserves it was a 3-1 home victory over Queens Park Crescents. Robert Newman, George Onwusonye and Timmy Akerele all finding the back of the net against a lone Crescents reply from Oscar Szarycz.

There were mixed fortunes for the two newly promoted sides. Stotfold Development with a hat-trick from Kurtis Alleyne and a single strike from Callum Mullins winning 4-1 at Marston Shelton Rovers for whom Perry Connolly netted. Whilst Barton Rovers Reserves were beaten 2-3 at home by Shefford Town & Campton Reserves. Matty Blake netting both of the home goals and Liam Wood, Ross Earl and Charlie Caulder all on the Town's scoresheet.

Two games were to finish all square, at Gold Street, Riseley Sports with a goal in each half from Lewis Donald and Sonny Newton Cootes had to settle for a share of the points in a 2-2 draw against Elstow Abbey who replied via Glenn Tumulty and Steve Chapion. Whilst over at The Keech Hospice Care Stadium, it was the same scoreline between hosts Biggleswade United Reserves and Flitwick Town. Frallias Mienambolo with a home brace and Tom Barrett and Tom Stanley marking the Town scoresheet.

The final game seeing AFC Oakley net a 4-3 home victory over AFC Kempston Hammers. Louis Green, Joe McDonagh, Stuart Gillies and Elijah Hukin on the home scoresheet against Hammers replies via Drey Mahanzu, Dunell Mahanzu and Dimagio Robinson.

Division One

The standout result of the day belongs to Lea Sports PSG, the 6-2 home winners over St Josephs (Saturday) Joe Hennem with a brace and single goals from Ryan Darby, Rhys Cadger, Ethan McEvoy and Cameron Davies doing the damage against Joe's replies via Jack Thompson and Michael Tunbu.

However, not that far behind was Henlow's 2-1 away victory at Totternoe Reserves. Tyler Howden the hero with a brace against a lone reply from Lee Loasby for the home side.

Over at Kingfield, Bedford Albion marked their return to the league with a 5-2 away win over league newcomers Bedford Town Under 23's. It was the Town who netted first in the 28th minute via Ollie Foley before a headed reply arrived from Keshawn Sergeant eight minutes later to send the sides in at half-time all square.

Within a minute of the restart Jamie Hall had placed the Albion 2-1 ahead only to see on 63 minutes Luigi Depiro levelled matters at 2-2. Albion were back in front when Hall grabbed his second of the day seven minutes later before Michal Michalski (72 mins) and Pasquale Grasso (87 mins) completed the scoring.

Also enjoying life on the road were Cranfield United Reserves the 4-1 winners at league newcomers Buffs FC. Jack Sharman- Dodd netting twice alongside single goals from Robert White and Samuel Manning against a lone home reply from Joe Jenkin.

Renhold started life back in Division One with a 3-1 home victory over Clifton thanks to goals from Shane Cox, Serge Kadji and Dan Thomas against a lone reply via Luke Freeman. Whilst Lewsey Park and AFC Oakley Reserves drew 2-2. Meshach Cole and James Brandon the home goalscorers against a brace in reply from Harvey Holland for the visitors.

Sporting Carpathians were to emerge the day's top scorers running out 6-3 home winners over Stopsley United. There was also home wins for FC Haynes and Shefford Town & Campton Development. The FC with goals from Lee Phillips, Dan Bright, Ross Airson and Scott Fruscante beating The 61 FC Luton Reserves 4-1 for whom Leroy White netted. Whilst Shefford were 2-0 home winners over AFC Bedford United thanks to goals from Charlie Perrett and San Lummis.

Elsewhere, Bedford SA with a brace from Ollie Hughes and a strike from Colby Smith were 3-0 ahead after 55 minutes at home against Westoning Recreation before the visitors staged a comeback with a brace from Charlie Scott and a goal from Bradley Freeman to earn a draw.

For Harlington Juniors it was a 2-2 home draw against Caldecote Reserves. Ben Whalley and Matt Coffey on their scoresheet against replies via Carl Heath and Lloyd Jones. Whilst it was a repeat 2-2 between Wilstead and Flitwick Town

Reserves. Joe Sullivan and Max Natola on the home scoresheet and Luke Dallen and Dale Goldie reply for the Town.

There was mixed results for two league newcomers, for Caddington it was a 3-2 home victory over Lea Sports PSG Reserves with goals from George Burden, Rayvaun Bridgett and Ollie Benham against PSG replies via Dylan Cadger and Ryan Bean. Whilst Stotfold Juniors were beaten 2-3 at home by Sharnbrook Reserves. Thomas Phelan, Nathan Ohalaron and Charlie Hurley on the visitors scoresheet against home replies from Ross Irving and Joe Cleverly.

For FC Polonia (Luton) it was a 2-1 home win over Kempston Rovers BCFL. with goals from Mateusz Antoniuk and Sylwester Krasko against a lone reply from Emmanuel Kontoh. Whilst Sandy were held to a 3-3 draw by Newham United. Jack Hutchinson with a brace and a single goal from Darren Jones on the home scoresheet against United replies via an own goal plus Sam Woodman and Igor Zieba.

Elsewhere, M&DH Clapham Sports drew 0-0 at home against FC Haynes Reserves and the Atletico Europa game v Square FC was postponed after Europa were found to not be affiliated to the Beds FA for season 2022-23 by the previous days deadline.

The biggest winners of the day were Luton Panthers who ran out 5-1 home winners over Marston Shelton Rovers Reserves. Luciano Witter netting twice alongside single goals from Kamran Khan, Curtis Long and Zain Rashid to bring up the nap hand against a lone Rovers reply from George Rogers.

The only other home win of the day saw league newcomers Bedford Wanderers beat Revivalists 3-2 thanks to a Luke Foster hat-trick against replies via Kanu Santigie and Kyron Matthews.

The biggest of the three away winners were Clifton Reserves 3-0 at Kempston Athletic. Matty Law, Jack Konopka and Tony Norman all finding the back of the net. Whilst both the other games finished 2-3. Josh Hughes, Jason Bako and Sam Chick netting the goals that took M&DH Clapham Sports Reserves to victory at CS Rovers for whom Daniel Bhatti and Ben Rodgers scored.

Matthew Rosborough with a brace and Alex Hardwick being the Meltis Rangers marksmen in their likewise win at Catsbrook Wanderers who replied via Luke Smith and Nick Sharpe.

Meantime, Blunham required two own goals and a strike from Robbie Richmond to earn a point from their 3-3 home draw with Leighton Woodside Adult for whom Ethan West, Thomas Bassett and Roy Burke found the back of the net.
