Off to a Flying Start

With the league season now just less than a month away we take this opportunity to have a look at the days opening fixtures in the Premier Division supported by Sportsform to ascertain if we can pinpoint the seasons early high flyers.

Current champions Caldecote will travel to Lodge Road to face Sharnbrook in the knowledge that for the past seven seasons their only blimp on having a perfect 100% winning start to the campaign was last seasons 1-1 home draw with Renhold United, whilst the home side have been beaten on the opening day for the past three seasons.

Two clubs who normally get their season off to a flyer meet on The Green, where Ickwell & Old Warden will entertain Renhold United. The home side having a perfect 100% record for the past five seasons, an achievement even more remarkable as all five games were played away from home. Whilst United were last beaten in their opening game of the season as long ago as season 2002-03 when they lost 3-4 at home to Luton Borough.

Another club unbeaten in their opening game of the campaign for the past five seasons are AFC Kempston Town who will be in home Hillgrounds action against the travelling Riseley Sports. The Sportsman have been asked to journey three times away from their Gold Street base in the past seven seasons to commence their season and on each occasion they have returned empty handed.

For the two league newcomers, Southill Alexander perhaps will be heartened to hear visitors Woburn have won just twice on the opening day of the season in the past seven campaigns and perhaps Biggleswade United Reserves will face a tougher task at Second Meadow when hosting Dunton. The visitors having been asked to travel just once away from Horseshoes Close in the past six seasons, this ending in a 1-0 victory over Sandy Reserves in season 2007-08.

At Rectory Road, Campton will host Oakley Sports in a repeat of last seasons opening game which ended in a 3-3 draw, but with the home side having won five of their previous six starts to the season against the Sportsman's record of two wins over the same period of time, it will be the home side who will start favourites to collect the three points on offer.

Over at Moggerhanger Playing Fields, hosts Blunham will be seeking their third opening day win on the bounce but should be aware that visitors Westoning Recreation Club have won their opening day game of the campaign on five occasions during the last seven seasons.

The final game at Miller Road, would look to favour hosts Meltis Corinthians who have been beaten just twice in the past seven seasons on the opening day whilst visitors Wilshamstead, having been asked to travel away from Jubilee Playing Fields in four of the last five seasons, are yet to return with a full haul of three points.
