Registration Forms (covered under league rule 8)

All registrations are now conducted in Whole Game via each individual clubs Team Administrators and likewise all transfers.

Clubs are advised when making new registrations they search for the player by name and date of birth only.

The golden rule of making registrations is that if you know this player has played any previous competition football in his life then he will already have a fan. If you cannot find him, don't open a new fan, seek help to avoid the risk of making a duplicate registration and running the risk of a possible breach of league rules.

With regard to transfers please note the league will not approve any transfers under the waived banner until the leaving club has notified the league they are happy for the transfer to go ahead.

All clubs are advised/requested to check and ensure all registrations made have transferred correctly across from Whole Game into Full Time.

Clubs are not allowed to cancel players' registrations once the season has commenced; they can only leave via a transfer.

Full Time Available Players List

Clubs are reminded of the note that appears on your match day available players list which reads. " Players above are registered with the competition on the above date of this game. These may include players who are cup tied, or otherwise not eligible to play because they are under suspension- clubs should check with their County FA or on the Whole Game system for details of current suspensions."

It is the clubs 100% total responsibility to ensure they do not play players who are serving a FA suspension and the league's recommendation is they visit the Whole

Game system prior to each game to check for any suspensions in place at any given date.

Teamsheet Notes -

. Please note the names of your players must show both forenames and family names and the number of the shirt each player is going to wear in the game.

Far too many clubs in the past couple of seasons failed to display the correct number shirt against their players, please ensure this does not happen again in season 2022-23.

This season, all match officials are being instructed to refuse any sheet not completed in this manner.

Please note the exchange of team sheets should take place at least 15 minutes prior to kick off in presence of the Match Day Referee.

Result Sheets

_Please note the deadline for your entry onto the Full Time Website is within 3 days of the match. **Please note loading of these result sheets must be made via Full Time. The FA App does not link into the results system and should not be used.**

Thus the deadline is Tuesday Midnight following any given Saturday game.

For Monday games it would be the Thursday Midnight following and for Wednesday games it's the Saturday Midnight following.

Please ensure you spend a minute or so checking your entry as in each of every weekend last season at least one club and often up to six clubs had omitted to submit a referee mark.

Please note all result sheets are to be retained for possible inspection during the course of the season.

Match Day Reporting of Result (covered under league rule 11B)

The deadline for this to happen is within one hour of the match finishing. To clarify the actual time the league regards this to be three hours from the scheduled kick off time.

If 2pm Kick Off then it's 5pm. If 2.30 pm Kick off then its 5.30pm. An additional 15 minutes will be allowed when involved in County Cup/ League Cup Ties that go to a penalty shoot-out.

Please remember if you are the away side in any County Cup Tie against opponents from outside our league then your club becomes responsible for reporting the result as above. Otherwise it's just the home side.

The preferred method is by text to 07779680269 – otherwise a phone call to the same number is quite acceptable – **please refrain from leaving messages on the answer phone**, if the line is busy then please wait a few moments and redial or send a text.

Match Day information required for Press Reports etc.

When reporting the above result please provide the name of your goalscorers and any additional information such as sequence of the scoreline, time of goals, red cards, penalty misses/saves or anything unusual of note.

It would also very much assist if when you are the away team that the same information is supplied.

Whilst Caldecote were held to a 2-2 home draw by Biggleswade United Reserves. Giuseppe Fallano netting both of the home goals against United replies via George Heaps and Brad Heaps.

Bedfordshire FA Senior Trophy 1st Round

For Elstow Abbey it's an away trip in round two to either Biggleswade United Reserves or Cranfield United after they ran out 7-0 home winners over AFC Kempston Town Hammers. The game was all but over by half-time with goals from Glenn Tumulty (4 mins) Steve Gentle (10 mins) and Scott Alleyne (32 mins) with the major surprise being it was not until Gentle netted again in the 61st minute that one could say " thats game over" the fifth goal arrived via Tumulty on 83 minutes before strikes from Craig Damon and Alleyne with his second of the afternoon in the closing minute saw the scoreline increased up to seven.

Elsewhere, Queens Park Crescents with two goals from Mohammed Omar and a strike from Robert Daltilia the 3-1 home winners over Barton Rovers Reserves for whom Adam Woodley netted. The Crescents in round two will be on the road to face Potton United Development. But for Flitwick Town it will be a home encounter in round two with Real Bedford following their 4-3 victory at Riseley Sports. Phil Matthews with a brace plus goals from Tom Barnett and Billy Harmer- Hankey doing the damage against home replies via an own goal plus Sam Harrison and Mitch Crook.

Alas it was the end of the cup road for Stotfold Development who had just a goal from Gabriel Ryan to show from their 4-1 defeat at Totternhoe. All four home goals coming from Kadeem Gutzmore.

Division One

There is no change at the head of the Division One standings following wins for the top three teams. Lea Sports PSG remaining three points clear at the head of the standings after they retained their season's unbeaten ways with a 3-2 victory at Renhold. Callum Jones netting twice and Rhys Cadger once against a home brace in reply from Reece Baker. Whilst second place Henlow ran out 4-1 home winners over Lewsey Park to retain their season's 100% home record. Robert Fitzgerald, Max Newton, Cameron Care and a Aldous Taylor penalty only being replied to once by Chris Gibson for the Park.

For third place Totternhoe Reserves it was win number five on the bounce to retain their season's 100% away record when a lone goal from Riley Keeble saw them home 1-0 at Clifton who were being beaten on home soil for the first time this season.

The highest scorers of the day were Milton Keynes Dons Set U19 who returned to winning ways for the first time in four outings with a 5-1 home victory over Bedford Albion. Desian Mehmetaj with a brace plus goals from Kingsley Bates, Ryan Flanagan and Finlay Eames- Illingworth bringing up the nap hand against a lone

Albion reply via Jamie Hall. Whilst Bedford Town U23's claimed their first league win of the season with a 4-2 home victory over Cranfield United Reserves. Adam Ahmed Pearce with a brace plus Sean Byrne and Louis Johnson finding the back of the net against United replies via Josh Thomas and James Manning.

Also winning 4-2 at home were AFC Oakley Reserves over Kempston Rovers Academy..Ray Patrickson with a brace plus goals from Michael Frezza and Mark Thynne doing the damage against Rovers replies via Mykola Felenko and Harvey Williams. Whilst Buffs FC were the 4-1 away winners at Wootton Blue Cross. Luke Hennessey with a brace plus goals from Andrew Truett and James Thompson only being replied to once by the home side's Joe Bygraves.
